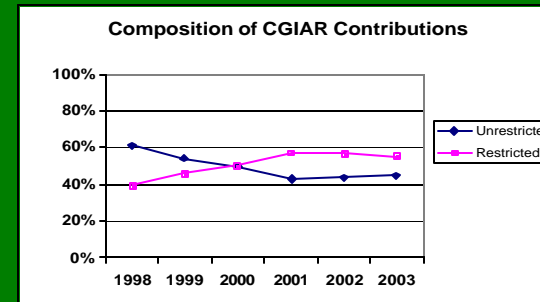
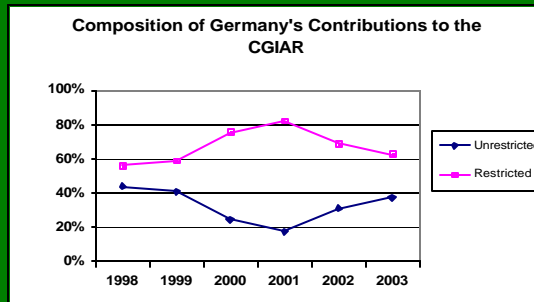
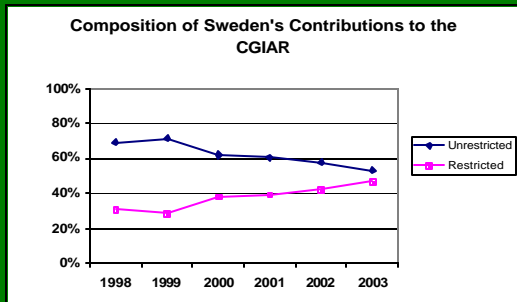
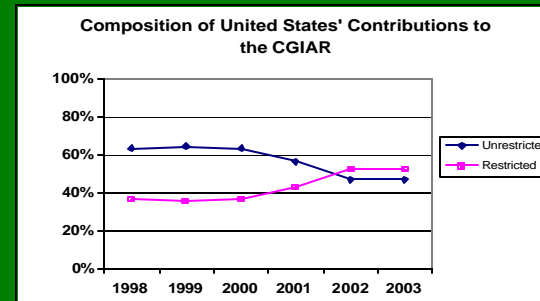
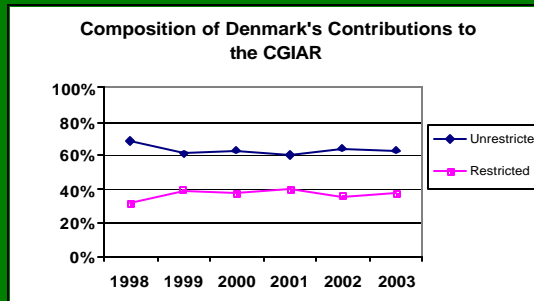
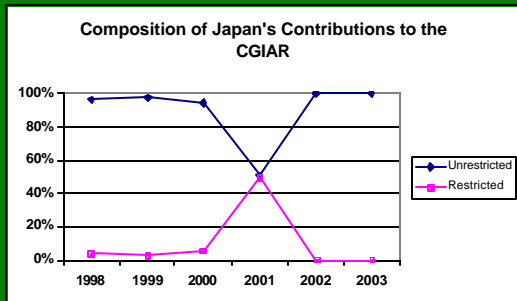
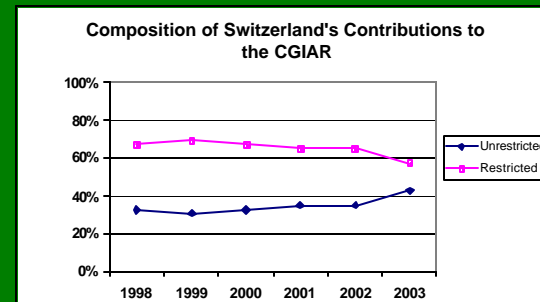
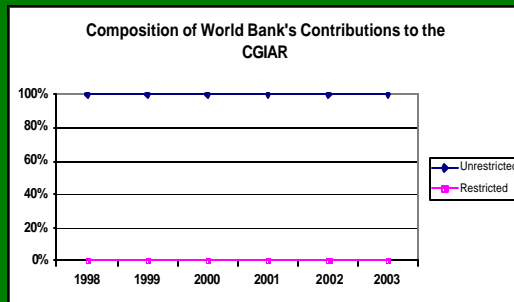
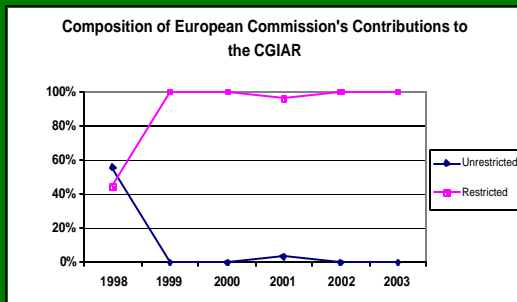
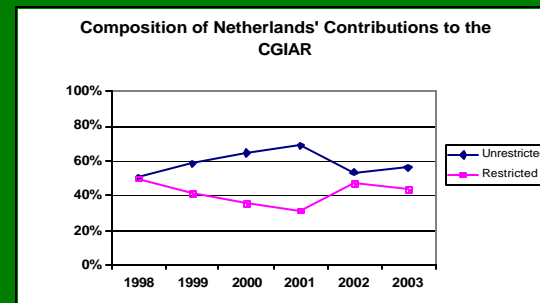
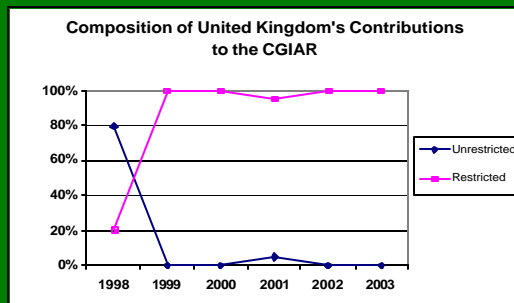
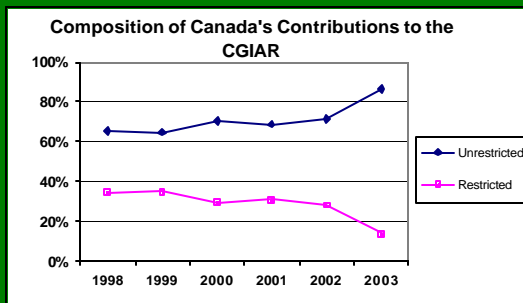
## Growth of the CGIAR - 1994-2004

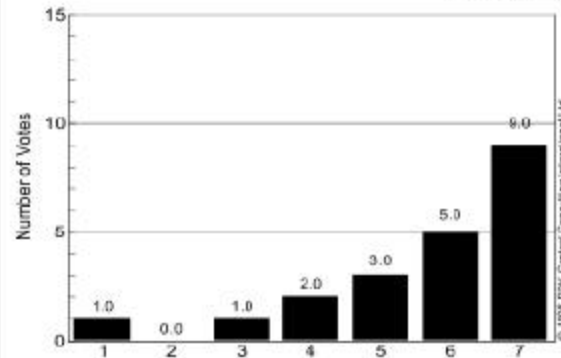

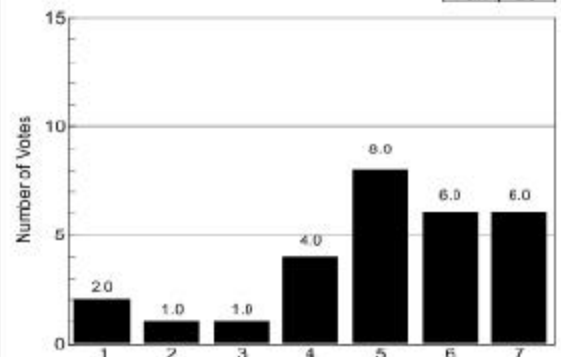

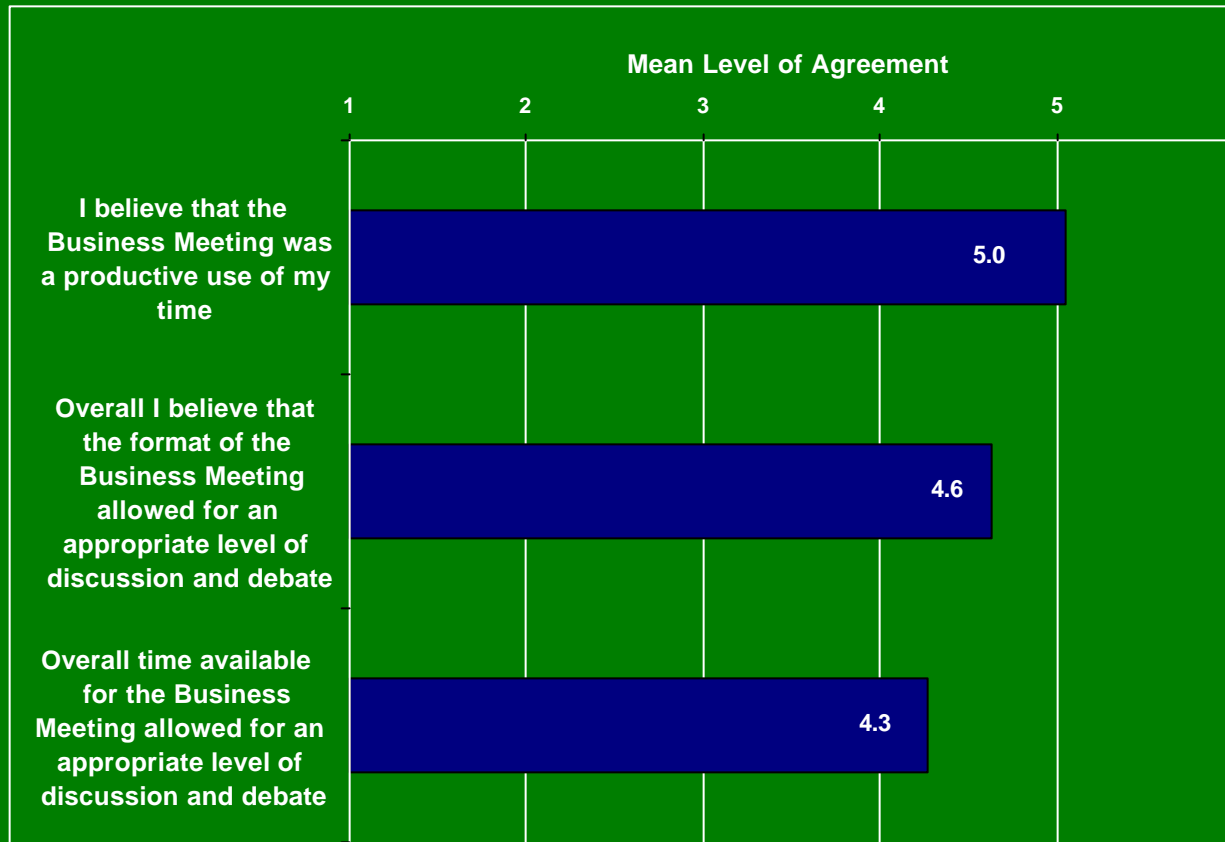

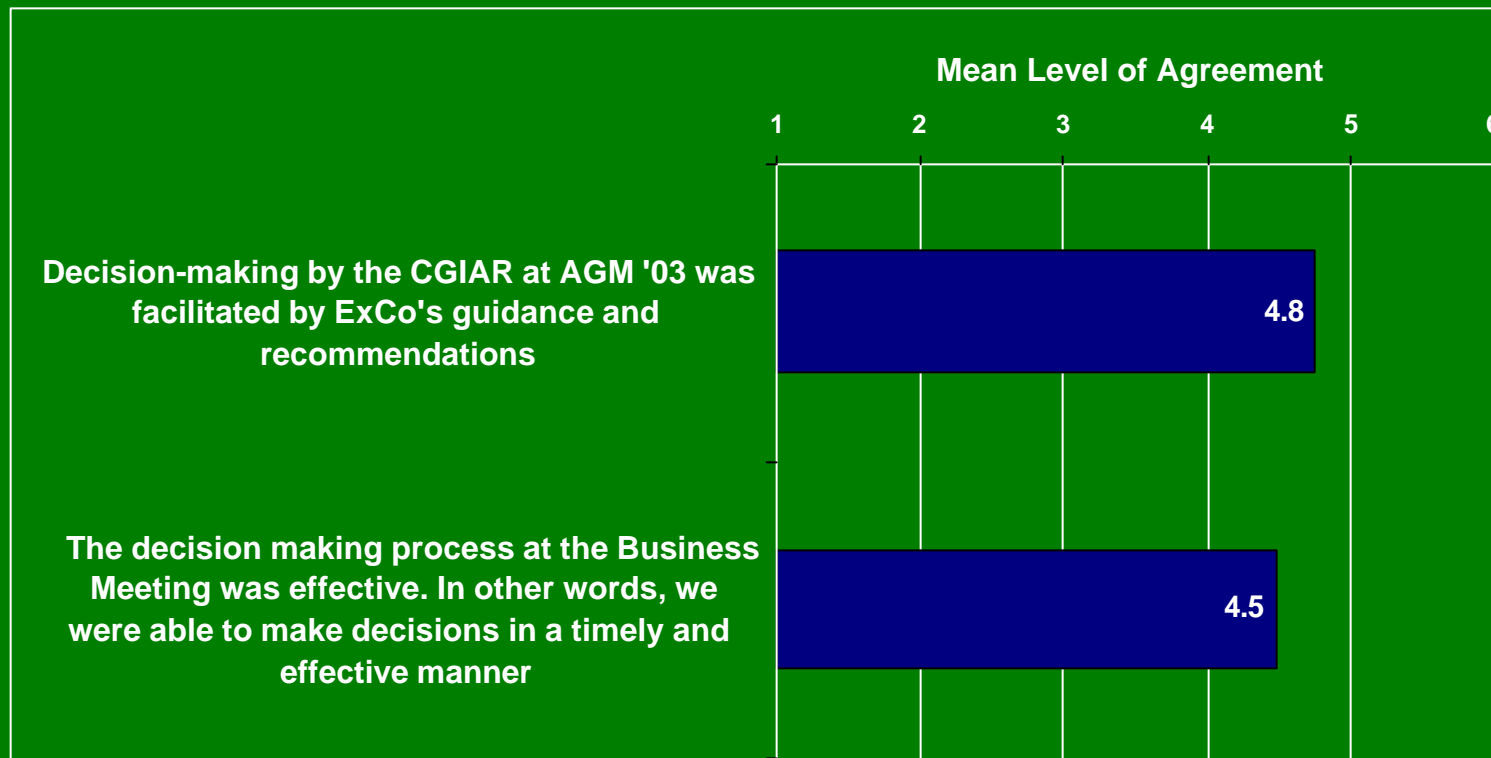
# AGM'03 Survey: highlights

- Objectives
  - Seek views on AGM
  - Stakeholder meeting
  - Business meeting
- Meetings valuable use of time (scale 1-6)
  - 4.9 in 2003, up from 4.6 in 2002
  - Member and Centers Day received approval rating = 4.7
  - 5.0 rating for Innovation Marketplace
- ExCo
  - 75% felt ExCo was sufficiently transparent
  - Documentation rated positively = 4.8
- AGM location
  - 52% felt South location (2-3 yrs) followed by North
